RIJRA Windstorm or Hail Coverage Limitation placed in effect

As of 8:00 a.m. on July 3, 2014, the Rhode Island Joint Reinsurance Association (RIJRA) has instituted a Windstorm and Hail Coverage Limitation.

The RIJRA attaches these endorsements to policies, under certain circumstances, when the National Weather Service has issued a Watch or Warning for a Tropical Storm or Hurricane for any point on the United States coast North of Latitude 35.3º North (North Carolina – Virginia State boundary).

The RIJRA attaches the "Windstorm and Hail Limitation" endorsements in the following situations:

- 1. Immediate Certification and New Business Approvals the Association will attach the endorsement on those applications where no prior insurance has been in effect or where prior coverage has been allowed to lapse.
- 2. Endorsements Where the request is for an increase in coverage limits, the "Windstorm and Hail Limitation" would apply to the amount of increase if the increase is approved.

The Windstorm or Hail Limitation does not apply and the endorsement will not be attached when:

- 1. The "Windstorm and Hail Limitation" endorsements will not be attached when coverage is needed for a new purchase where the passing date falls during the period where a Watch or Warning has been issued.
- 2. The endorsement will also not be attached to policies seeking coverage as a result of cancellation or non-renewal by the prior carrier so long as the application is otherwise acceptable to the Association and coverage has not been allowed to lapse.
